NON-PROFIT

Construction Angels is an approved IRS 501-(c)(3) Non-Profit Public Charity. That exemption allows Construction Angels to collect funds and provide the donor with a valid tax deduction and will allow it to be exempt from certain state and federal taxes.

Construction Angels, Inc. is a Non-Profit Corporation that aids families in need of financial assistance when a construction employee has lost his/her life in an on-the-job accident. Many times when a household suffers a loss of life while working on a construction jobsite, there are little or no funds available to the family to accommodate the children left behind. CA main objective is to help families pick up the pieces.

CA is an Organization focusing on the construction worker's spouse and children left behind. Its services are designed to provide an integrated approach to create quality of life for family members whose household has had the misfortune to be involved in a tragic and fatal accident. We hope to facilitate the avoidance of unexpected paths for workers and their families via facilitating access to safety information and providing a smooth transition if an unexpected path does occur.

ABOUT US

Construction Angels, Inc. is a Non-Profit organization created to facilitate access to financial and supportive services to the surviving family member(s) of a construction worker who has suffered the loss of life arising while in the course and scope of their workplace duties.

Qualifying incidents shall be defined based on the prevailing workers compensation laws and definitions of the state where the accident or incident occurred.

Financial assistance shall be in the form of providing funds for surviving children and/or limited immediate financial assistance for a surviving spouse.

In addition, the Organization will be a conduit to preventative safety and training information along with other household financial planning and family member counseling services.

What qualifies a Construction Angel?

- A construction worker who loses their life on the jobsite during the course and scope of employment; Victim's Human Resources Department contacts Construction Angels, and
- Completes Preliminary Assistance Request Form and other necessary forms
 - Provides the contact information of the beneficiary
 - Submits a Memorial statement to Construction Angels Chapter
