Dear Friends and Families,

On behalf of Construction Angels, thank you for taking a moment to learn more about our mission — a mission that exists because every life lost in construction leaves behind a family forever changed.

Construction Angels is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization that provides immediate financial assistance and grief counseling to the children (age 19 and younger) and spouse left behind when a construction worker is involved in an accidental work-related fatality. These families are the heart of our mission, and they need our support more than ever.

With over 7.2 million individuals working in the construction industry, it is critical to understand the risks that come with building the world around us. According to OSHA, more than 5,000 workplace fatalities occur annually in the U.S., and over 20% of those are in construction. These are not just numbers. These are mothers and fathers, daughters and sons, friends, and neighbors — the very people who build our roads, homes, schools, and communities. These same workers also rebuild our communities when a disaster happens, such as a hurricane, tsunami, earthquake, or other deviation happens to our way of life.

Since our founding in June 2011, Construction Angels has provided **over \$950,000*** in financial aid and grief counseling services to families in their greatest time of need, and CA provides scholarships to help qualified applicants and surviving children pursue their futures. This would not be possible without the continued support of our generous donors and “One of Our Own” across the country.

Construction workers often work in high-risk environments, many living paycheck to paycheck and serving as the primary providers for their families. When tragedy strikes, the loss is not only emotional — it is financial. The Construction Angels Charity steps in to bridge the gap between the immediate financial support for the family and the pathway forward, reminding these families that they are not alone, and their loved one’s sacrifice is honored. Our work does not stop there. We are committed to expanding our impact over the next five years — growing our national presence, raising awareness, promoting job site safety, and continuing our Construction Angels Scholarship Program. Our goal is to support families, help raise awareness to reduce fatalities, and foster a culture that values and protects our construction workforce.
